Completion of the IO1



During the last months, wINGS was able to complete its first intellectual output, which consisted in analysing the competence framework on start-ups and entrepreneurs.

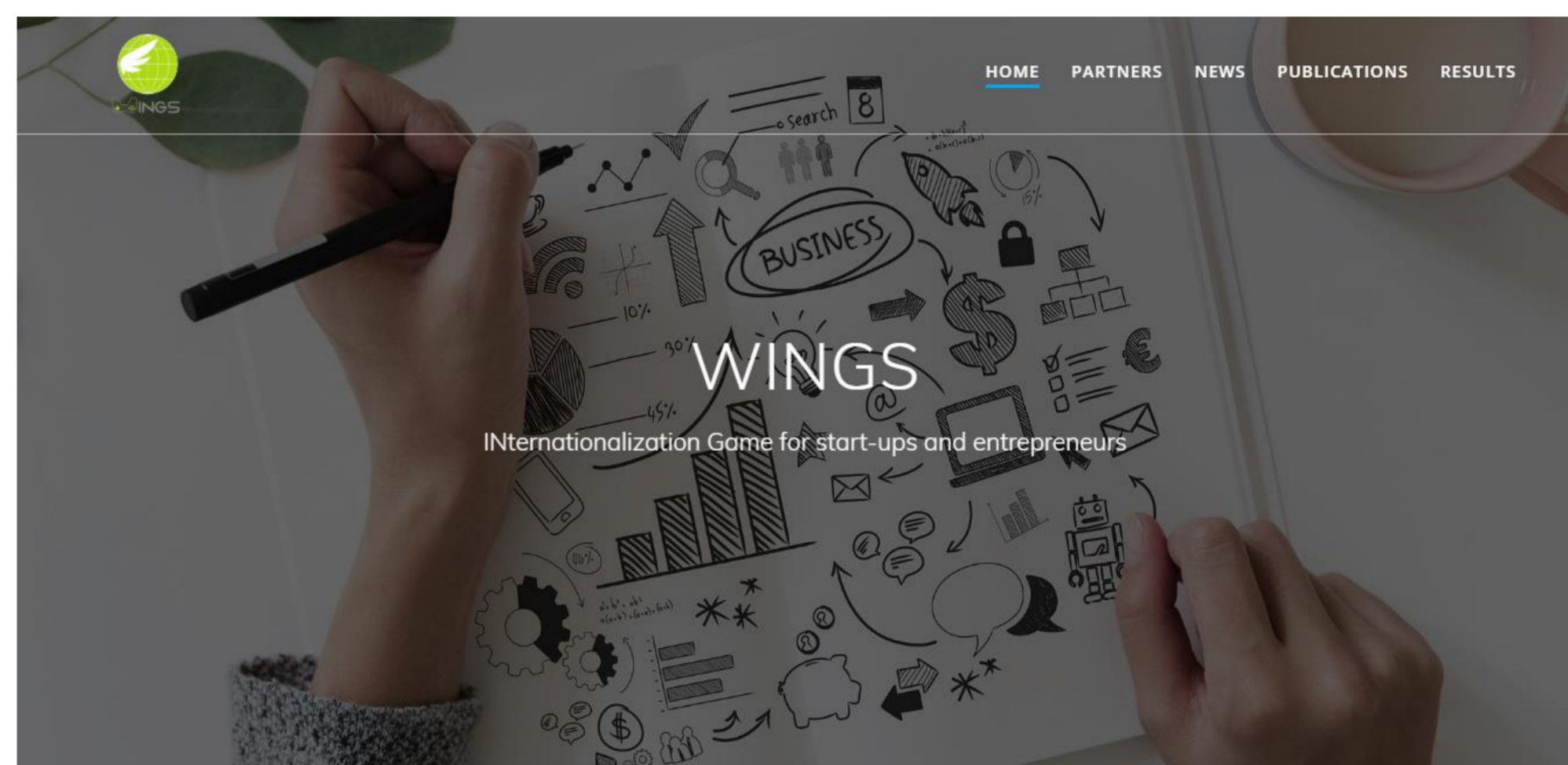
In order to achieve the output goals, a set of exploratory

activities was conducted in each partner's country, consisting of:

- **Desk research** – Each partner prepared a deep analysis about the entrepreneurial context of their respective countries, containing information about which are the main economic sectors, the scenario for internationalization, the characteristics of the entrepreneurial education and which are the competence gaps, training needs of entrepreneurs, good practices, etc.
- **Field Research** – It was conducted through two methods: On one hand, 50 online questionnaires in each country were spread and later collected among educators and trainers regarding the use of ICT in their lessons. On the other hand, a focus group was organized in each country in which 5 entrepreneurship-related people discussed and provided their vision and knowledge of the current entrepreneurial scenario.
- **Final Report** – All the information obtained from the whole research was merged into a comprehensive report prepared by Business Foundation for Education and on which the teaching notes would later be based.
